## 2018 FIELD TRIPS and ACTIVITIES

Our field trips are free and will take place rain or shine, but not during thunderstorms. On cloudy or showery days, we will have a general nature walk, and look for caterpillars, hiding butterflies and plants that butterflies use. With luck, the sun will come out and with it, the butterflies.

Our morning field trips last about two hours. Some trips have an option to continue into the afternoon, and others are all day trips, returning some time around 4 p.m. End times of outings are approximate. Bring a cold drink and for the longer trips, your lunch and folding chair.

We have provided contact numbers (all area code 585) in case you would like more information about a field trip. For most of our field trips, just come along to the meeting place listed. Also for most field trips, an alternate meeting place may usually be arranged, if needed, via one of the contact numbers. A few field trips do require pre-registration, as noted.

Please bring close focusing binoculars, a field guide and your camera, but leave your butterfly nets at home, because they can injure wings, legs and antennae.

Non-members, beginners and children accompanied by an adult are welcome at all of our activities.

\*\*\*\*\* **Long pants and appropriate footwear are strongly recommended, as there is often poison ivy \*\*\*\*\***  
**During recent years, there have been deer ticks in the area and cases of Lyme disease contracted here. Because of this, we recommend you wear long pants tucked into socks, and use insect repellent.**

**JUNE 27 GANARGUA CREEK MEADOW PRESERVE For mid-summer butterflies**  
Wed. 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. 727 Wilkinson Rd., Macedon NY 14502. Joint event with Genesee Land Trust.  
Meet at Creek-side entrance near intersection of Wilkinson and Victor Rd. in Wayne County, about 30 minutes from Rochester. **Directions:** From Route 31 in Macedon, turn south onto Route 306 (Wayneport Road). Turn east onto Wilkinson Road, and drive to the parking lot on the right, just before T intersection with Victor Rd. Wear long pants and appropriate footwear, as there is poison ivy. Optional bring lunch and folding chair.

**JULY 8 MENDON PONDS PARK For butterfly beginners walk**  
Sun. 10am to noon Meet in the Visitors Center / Wild Wings parking lot, 27 Pond Road, Honeoye Falls, NY 14472, just off Clover St. (Rt. 65). Joint trip with the Bird House. We will explore the butterfly garden and nearby meadows.

**JULY 11 BLACK CREEK PARK For butterflies and summer wildflowers**  
Wed. 10 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. with possible afternoon extension. Meet in the parking lot near Sunnyside Lodge in Black Creek Park 3835 Union St, North Chili, NY 14514. Joint trip with Burroughs Audubon Nature Club.  
**Directions:** Take Route I-490 west to Exit #4, go south on Union Street (Rt. 259) approx. one mile. Enter park, and at the T junction, turn right (north) and meet near restrooms. We will carpool from there to a nearby area of the park. If the weather is good, we may visit other parts of the park in the afternoon. Optional, bring lunch and folding chair for possible afternoon butterflying.

 Meet at Rush Park and Ride, then car pool to explore roadsides and visit a private property.  
**Directions:** Rush Park and Ride lot is at Rt. 15 and Rt. 251 off I-390, Exit 11 for Rush. State Forest area is about a half hour drive from Rush. Bring lunch and a folding chair. Contact: 385-3907.

**Directions:** Take 490 East to Bushnell's Basin / Route 96 Exit. At the light, turn left; the parking lot is on the left. We will car pool from there. About one hour drive to Montezuma area. Bring lunch and a folding chair

 Sun. 10 a.m. to noon 3728 Iroquois Rd., Caledonia NY 14423. Joint event with Genesee Land Trust.  
**Directions:** The preserve is located about two miles east of Caledonia on the south side of Iroquois Road (County Rt 21) between Wheatland Center Road and Feely Road. Please follow parking instructions upon arrival. Please be punctual. Once we leave the cars to follow the access easement, we will not be visible from the road. Wear waterproof boots or footwear you do not mind getting muddy and wet. Lunch optional. Contact: 383-8168.
